GLOSSARY OF CRSG TERMS

Certified DNA – Parentage traceable DNA through accepted studbooks as listed in the CRS Rules and Regulations.

Designated Breeder – a person who has leased a mare for the purpose of producing offspring and to whom the Owner of said mare has assigned breeding rights to as the “breeder” of the resulting foal(s)..

Markings (Acquired Identification) – any artificial marking such as freeze branding, hot branding, ear notching, tattoo, scar or other visible means of identification not present at birth, including microchipping.

Markings (Birth) – white markings, whorls, coat patterns such as dapple, primitive markings such as dorsal or leg stripes, shoulder patches, or spider webbing.

Stallion Agent - a person who has leased a stallion for the purpose of breeding mares and producing offspring, whether for themselves or outside mares, and to whom the Owner of said stallion has named as the recognized “agent” of the resulting breedings(s) giving said person the right to use said stallion and to sign off on Stallion Service Certificates required for that lease period.
