GRS Photograph submission

GRS requires a minimum of 5 specific photographed angles of your Gotland Pony to document the file. Taking photos from the proper angles is important. Bad angles distort conformation and may make it difficult to view the pony properly.

The photos should be taken on a level surface that does not obscure the hooves. Level pavement, dirt or flat gravel surfaces are good choices with a plain, uncluttered background. Standing on uneven surfaces, or uphill or downhill will distort the camera's eye of your pony's conformation.

REQUIRED PHOTOS:

1. Full RIGHT SIDE photo

2. Full LEFT SIDE photo

3. Full FRONTAL photo (including tips of ears to hooves) with the pony looking straight at the camera with a normal relaxed head position

4. Full HEAD (profile) photo - close up of pony looking at the camera (including tips of ears and all of chin)

5. Full REAR photo (including croup to hooves)

Additional photos are required for all white markings or any patterns (such as dorsal stripes, lacing, sabino spotting, etc.) Leg markings require all four angles – front, back, left, & right. If the left and right can be clearly seen in the body photos, only the front and back angles for leg markings are required.
